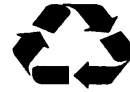

TRASH AND RECYCLING INFORMATION



ITEMS BEING RECYCLED



Have your garbage and recycling to the curb before 6am. Residents should have the garbage in plastic bags or in a container no larger than 32 gallon and the items should be bagged. All construction and demolition waste require special arrangements by calling out office at 1-800-248-2373.

NEWSPAPER, MAGAZINES, OFFICE PAPER

Must be in paper grocery bags or tied in bundles, including glossy inserts, catalogs, mail secular, phone books, paperback books, cereal boxes, envelopes, wrapping paper, etc.

CARDBOARD (FLATTENED)

Clean cardboard only. Must be broken down, flattened, and tied in bundles.

GLASS CONTAINERS (CLEAR, BROWN, GREEN)

All bottles must be rinsed and labels can stay on. No window glass, light bulbs, TV tubes, drinking glass, etc.

ALUMINUM

Aluminum beverage cans only. No aluminum foil, TV dinner trays, etc.

TIN AND BI-METAL CANS

This includes all soup, vegetable, juice cans, etc. All cans must be rinsed out completely.

PLASTIC CONTAINERS

This includes plastic bottles with the recycling symbol 1 and 7. All plastic bottles must be rinsed out completely.

Look for the symbol coding on the bottom of the bottle.

WASTE OIL

Common engine oil only. Must be in leak-proof, non-breakable containers. Max size: One gallon with lid. Two gallons per week.

LEAD ACID VEHICLE BATTERIES

Car and truck batteries only. Battery casing must be unbroken and the caps must be on.

TIRES

Please limit to two (2) tires per week, maximum of 8 per year. The tires must be off the rim, the rims will be taken by the trash driver.

Place your recyclable materials in the recycling container. This container is to be left with the residence if you move. Newspaper, cardboard, waste oil, and vehicle batteries can be placed along side your recycling container. Keep your recyclable materials separate from your other garbage and easily accessible.

APPLIANCE PICK-UP

Appliances such as stoves, clothes washers, dryers, water heaters, dishwashers, microwaves, refrigerators, freezers, air conditioners require special handling.

No Medical Waste – i.e. needles, rubber gloves, oxygen tubes, IV bags, etc.

No Yard Waste – it's illegal to landfill these items.

No Wet Paint or Hazardous Materials – contact your County Courthouse regarding disposal of these items.

Empty or Dry Paint Cans – may be set next to your trash with the lids removed.

HOLIDAY SCHEDULE

There will be **NO** pick up on the following days:

Thanksgiving Day

Christmas Day

New Year's Day

Memorial Day

Fourth of July

Labor Day

If the scheduled day of collection falls on the holidays listed above, the collection will take place on the next regular business day.
